7. Business Continuity Checklist (Ronald) for on/offboarding directors/officers and SOP sheet

- Need to ensure board directors, officers and volunteers are onboarded with access to the appropriate systems, and offboarded with downgraded or removed access as appropriate.
- Ronald proposed the new Secretary update one tab a month to ensure that there is some redundancy / back up for administration / management of our financial, technology, communications, membership systems, etc. Need to ensure everyone has access to what they need.

8. Awards Committee Report & Hugh Town Memorial Award (Graeme)

- Two nominations for 2020 Jan Chavarie and Drew Mitchell
 - Recommendation of form a Subcommittee for Hugh Town award to review nominations, avoids popularity contest
 - Suggestion of a template for criteria, Graeme developed one to use
 - Board will approve nomination
 - Suggestion of a Hall of Fame award as well as Builder's Award'
 - At 2020 AGM award will be presented to Drew Mitchell presented by Graeme

9. CORA sanctioned races:

- Review Proposed CORA Race Schedule at Pre-AGM (Ronald)
 - Prefaced by everything must be played by ear
 - Applications will be accepted later in the year, suggestion of 90 days before the event.
- Discuss CORA 2021 Winter Series races:
 - Hoping that restrictions will be lifted by the time the Winter Series starts
 - Conflict for Jericho and Darcy Island races Jericho cannot move the date, waiting on Lat 48 to advise if they can move Darcy Island.
 - May not be a conflict as Jericho is big boat and Darcy Island is small boat
 - Jericho has agreed to be CORA cup if there is a series.
- Discuss CORA Cup races vs regional races due to COVID-19
 - Should there be a CORA Cup series for 2021?
 - May do other formats for the CORA cup, decision to made in new year
 - List of races will be done by season and region for ease of reference, colour coding and spacing to be used.
 - Sproat offered to host Nationals
 - Flexibility on race schedule, should health and weather concerns prevent a small boat race from being run.

- Concerns regarding conflicting with big boat race date, big boat races have less flexibility to switch
- Any race date changes must be fit into the race schedule. In some instances, a race may just need to be cancelled.
- Suggestion of regional CORA races, big and small boat, culminating in regional nationals. As such conflicting dates shouldn't be a concern if in different regions.
 - May look into a spring small boat series, and potential summer small, depending on Provincial Health Guidelines and impact on crew boat racing
 - Clubs with dates reserved for big boat races will have first option to switch to small boat series
- Ideas to make CORA Cup points consolidation easier (Erik, Jonathan, Don & Graeme)
 Table this to new year
- Reminder of initiatives for consistency of presentations/recognition at CORA Cup races (Committee Rep)

Motion - For regional cup series \$500.00 toward apex race of Winter Series with the consideration to extend into successive seasons per region. The more races you do the more times your name is put in for a draw prize.

10. Discuss definition and criteria for CORA Clubs to be considered in "good standing":

- Review Grace/Jan's list of members grouped by-club
 - Each club must have at least 6 members registered with CORA with each member affiliated with that club.
 - Each club must be registered with CORA with the above criteria by July 1st. Or they will be removed and considered uninsured.
 - Any club that doesn't meet the requirements will be issued a notice and be given the opportunity to meet requirements
 - This doesn't mean that any particular club couldn't appeal this. This would relate to a club applying for grants from CORA

 - How many paddlers will the coach boat be needed for, rescue, etc.
